



BRUNO BAREL

He was born in Vittorio Veneto (Treviso) in 1952. He holds a Law degree from the University of Padua, and is a European Law teacher at the faculty of Law at the same University, and at the University of Venice, faculty of Economics, course of foreign commerce.

He is teacher of international and European law in several university Masters, specialisation schools and courses managed by the Judiciary High Council, the Triveneto Notary Association and law registers.

He is a lawyer and founder of the law office Barel Malvestio & Associati of Treviso.

He wrote several scientific publications, and is a member of the editing committee of some law magazines; he is also registered in the national journalist register since 1978.

In the last years he was member of the Bioethical Committee of the Venetian Region.

At present he is President of the Contracts Commission of Curia Mercatorum of Treviso (an association of five chambers of commerce), and a member of the scientific committee of the "Fondazione Gentile Onlus" in Padua.

Moreover he currently cooperates as expert with the technical commission for the fiscal federalism of the Ministry of Economy and Finance and is president of the board of directors of NUMERIA S.G.R. S.p.A., IRCA S.p.A. and SIPA S.p.A. of the Zoppas Industries Group.
