INFORMATION RELATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SHARE BUY-BACK PROGRAMME (PERIOD 8TH JULY – 12TH JULY 2019)

Biadene di Montebelluna, July 15, 2019 – Geox S.p.A. (“**Geox**”), under the share buy - back programme announced to the market on June 4, 2019 to buy back up to a maximum of 3,996,250 ordinary shares (equal to 1.54% of the current share capital) servicing 2019-2021 Stock Grant Plan – according to the provisions of the (EU) Regulation no. 596/2014 and the (EU) Delegated Regulation no. 1052/2016 - hereby announces to have acquired (in the period from 8th July 2019 to 12th July 2019) 156,338 ordinary shares (corresponding to 0.06% of the total number of ordinary shares) at a weighted average price of Euro 1.4192 for a total counter-value of Euro 221,868.38.

Purchases have been carried out by Goldman Sachs International and on the basis of the information provided by Goldman Sachs International itself, here below is a summary of the daily transactions on Geox shares (ISIN CODE IT0003697080), in aggregate form:
